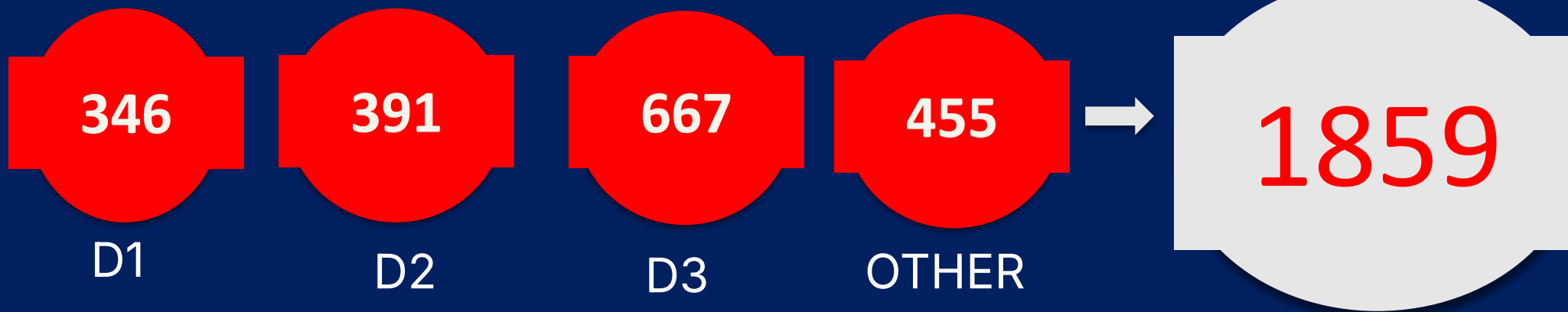

New This Year: Age Group Formation



- Beginning in 2026–27, U.S. Soccer, US Youth Soccer, AYSO, and US Club Soccer are moving to a school-year age group format (Aug. 1 – Jul. 31).
- Marin FC will comply with this standard, consistent with other clubs across Northern California.
- Marin FC will maintain a consistent, merit-based approach for all play-up requests.

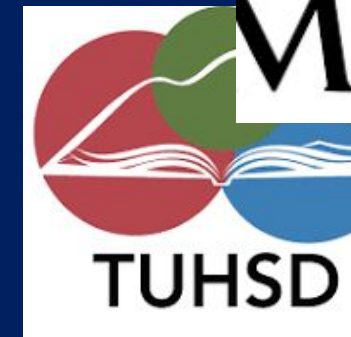

Understanding Financial Aid at Marin FC



Need based financial aid to ensure all players can participate regardless of family income:

- \$280,000 awarded annually in annual grants
- Assistance amounts vary based on household income
- Support for team fees, uniforms, travel subsidy upon application

Key Information for families:

Deadlines

- Current players - application due April 30th;
- New Players: U8-U14 (players younger than July 31, 2013) due May 10, 2026
- New Players: U15-U19 (players older than Aug 1, 2013) due May 24, 2026

- Registration fee - \$325 (*est)
- Team Fee Payment Schedule (7 payments):
 - Initial payment: June 1; 6 Monthly payments July - Dec
